42% live in Dane and Milwaukee CoCs

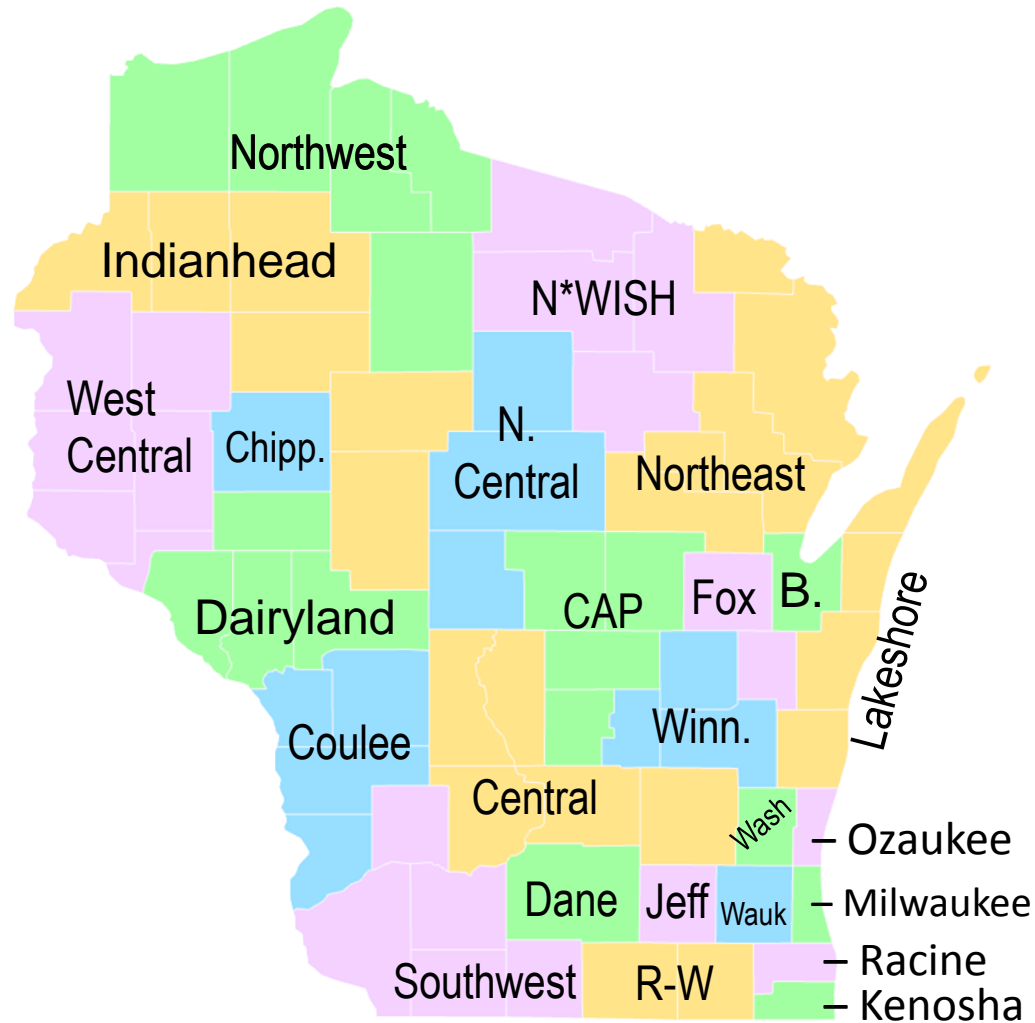


6% sleeping outdoors or in places not meant for human habitation

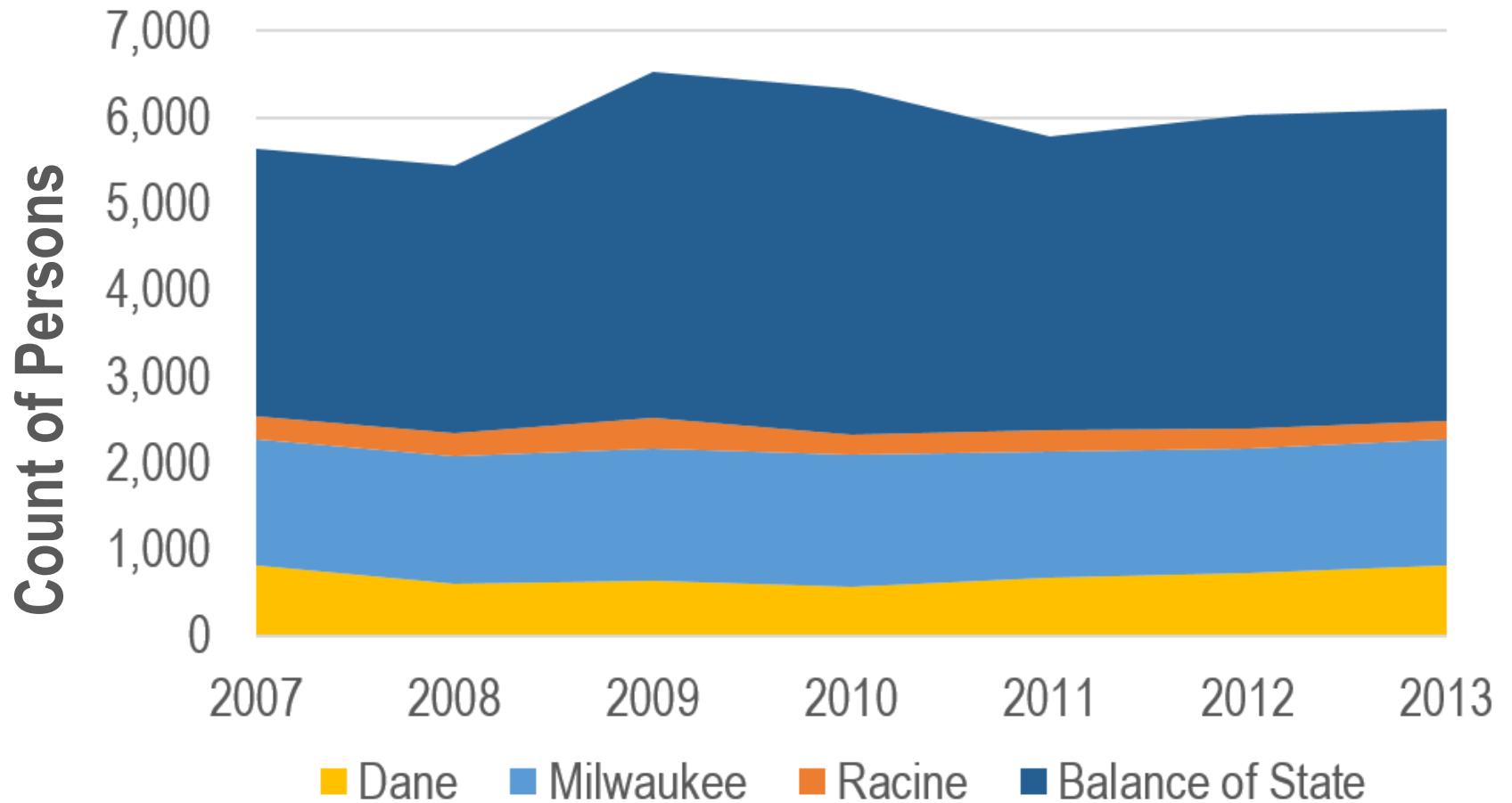

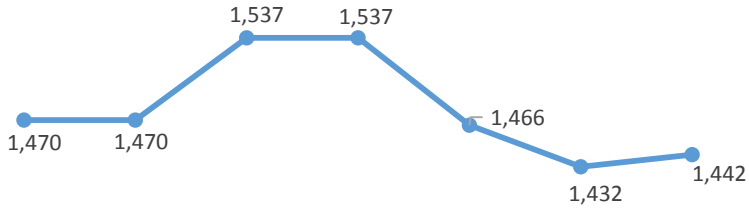

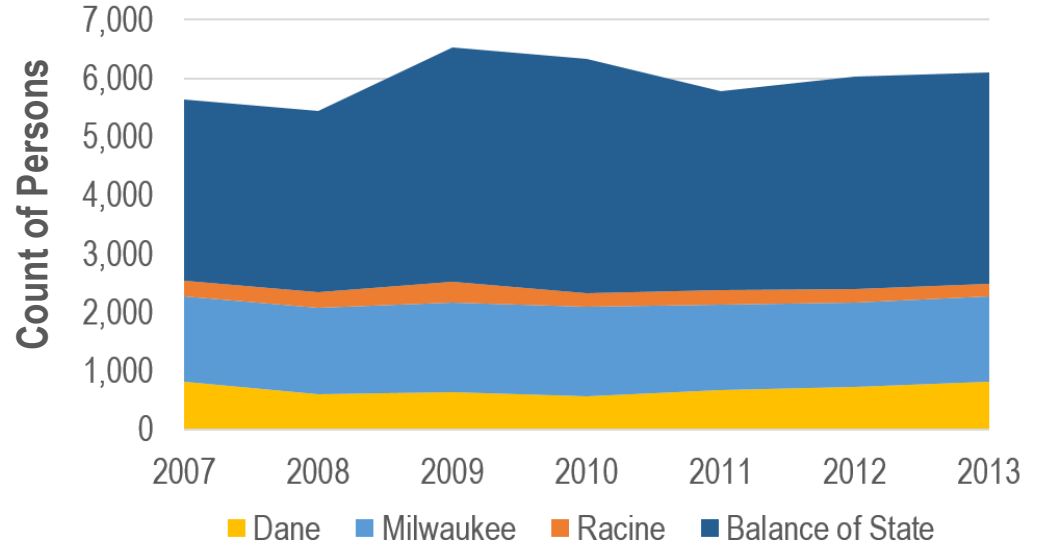

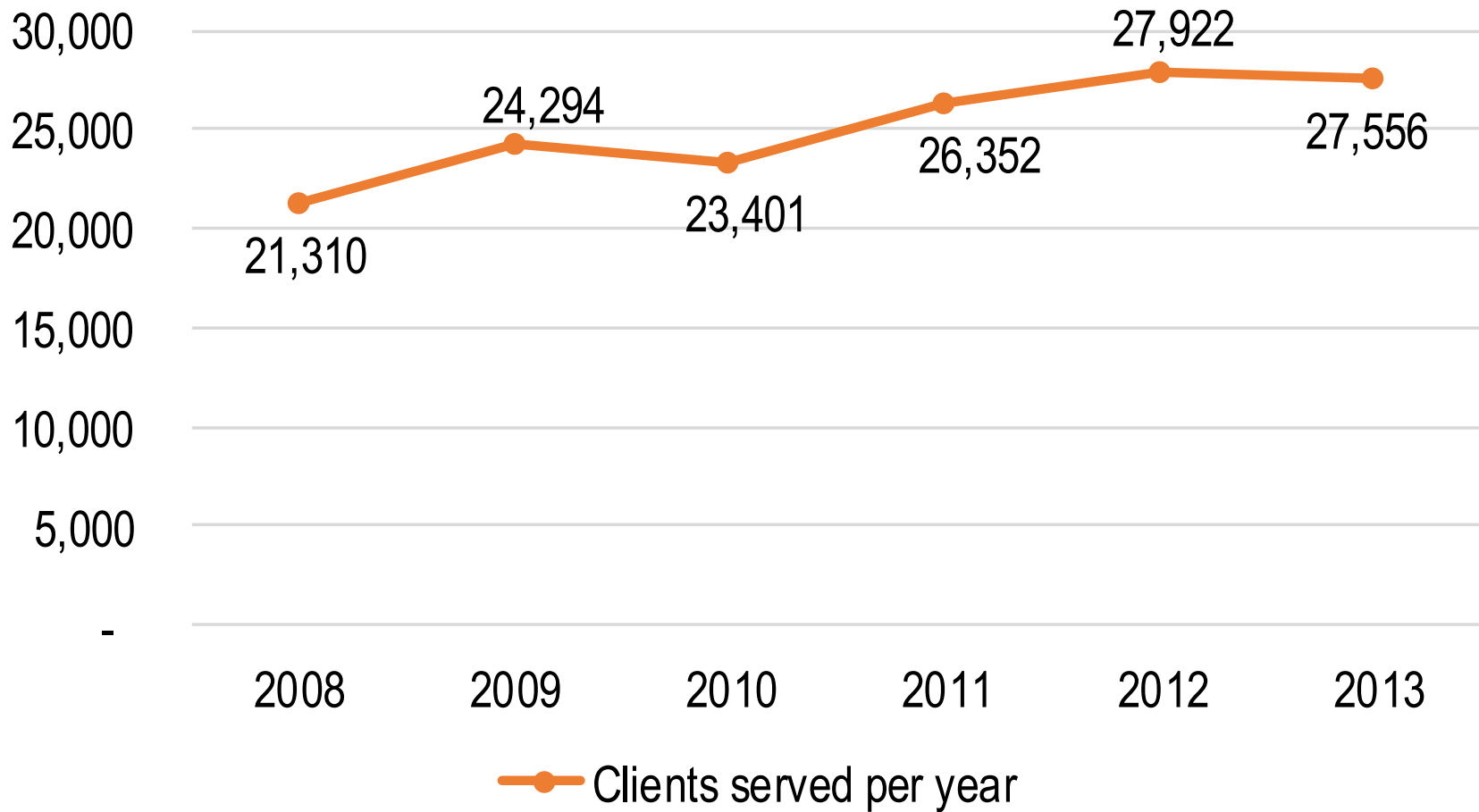

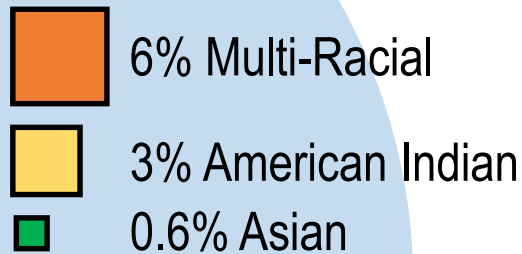

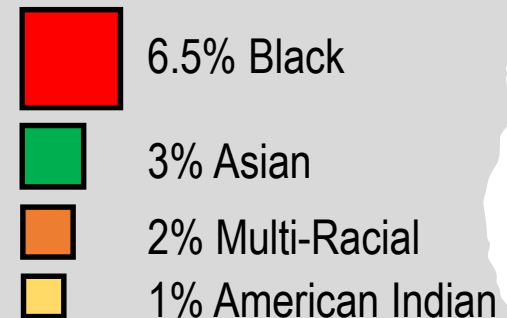
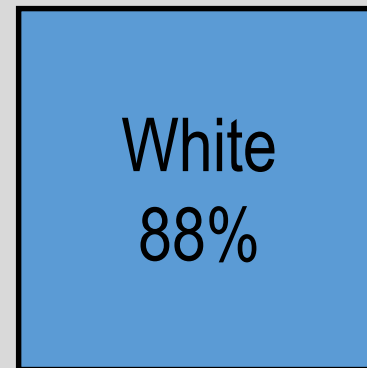

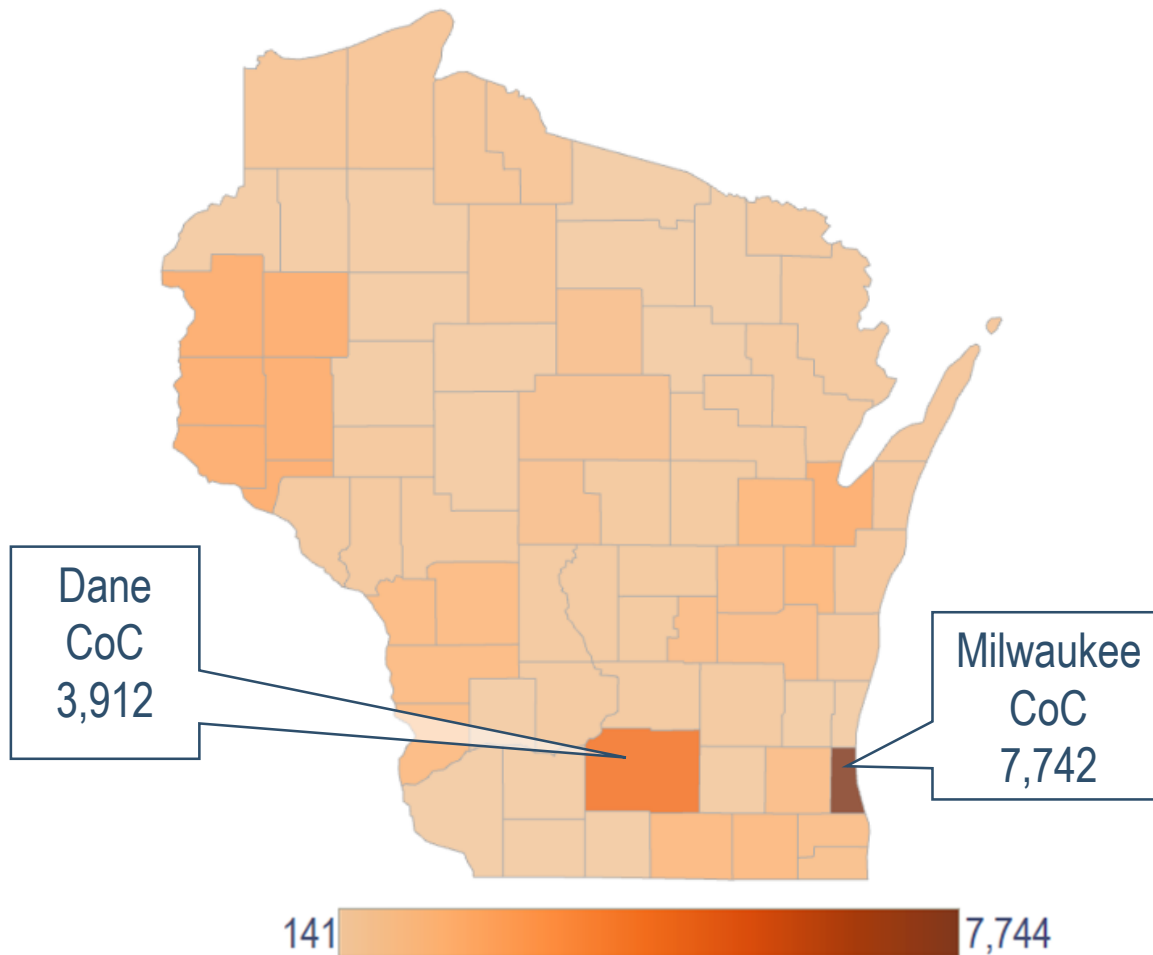
Race of Clients Experiencing Homelessness (2013)



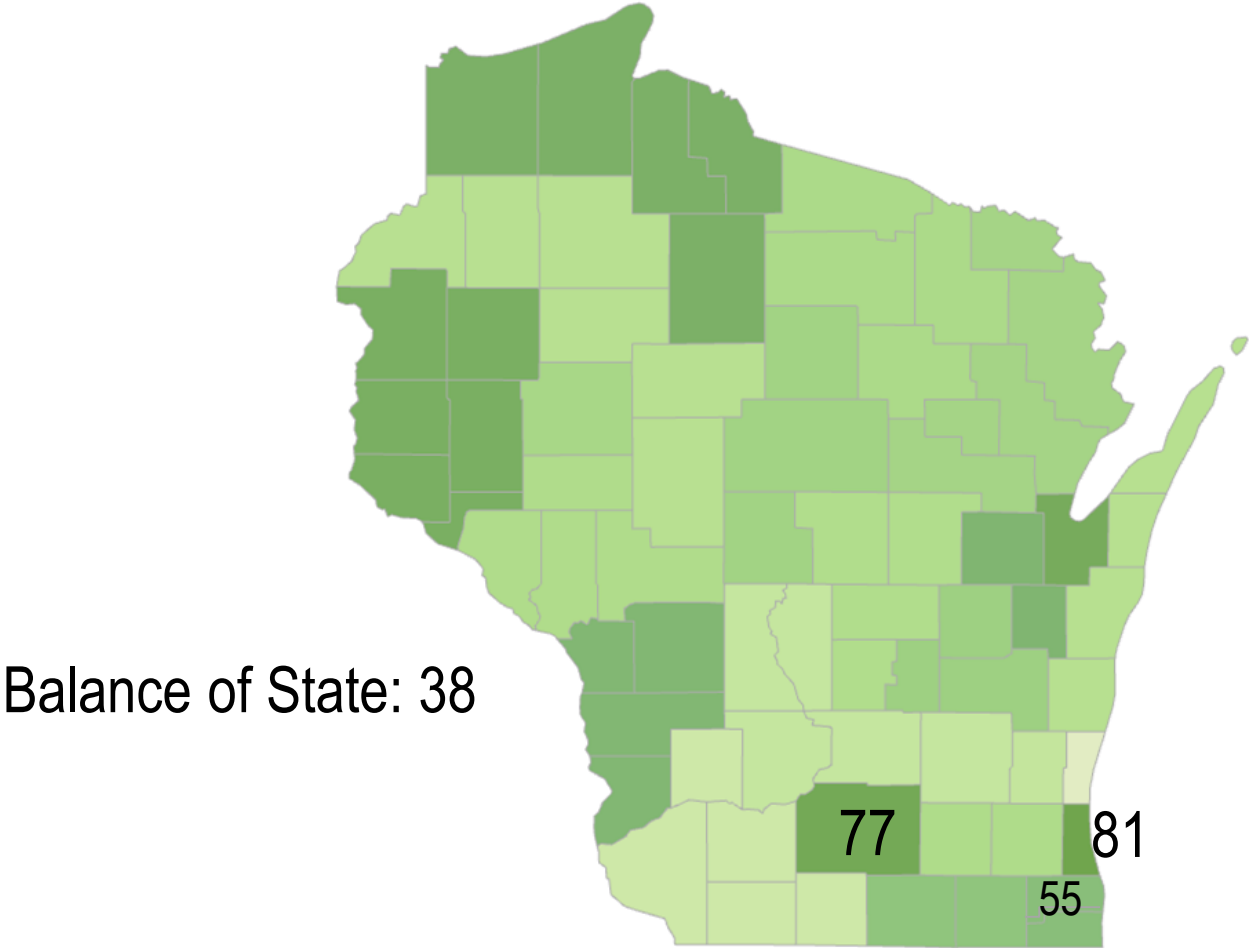
Race of Wisconsin Residents (2013)



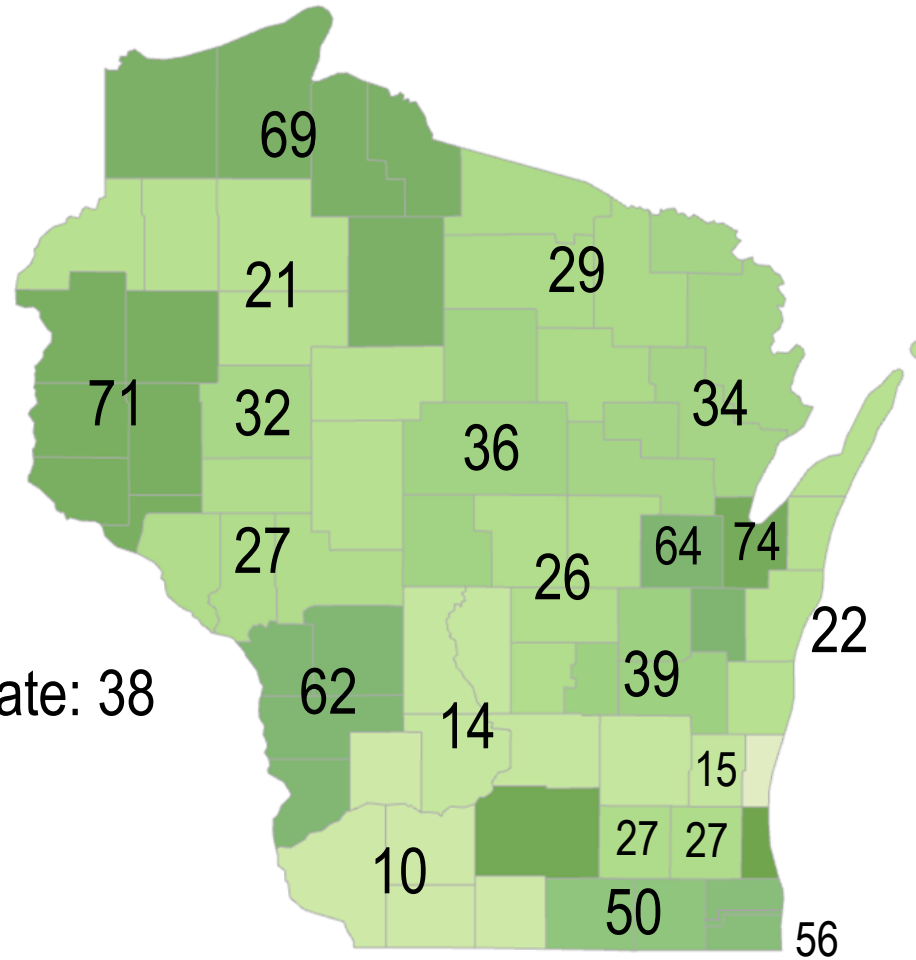
Distribution of Homelessness



Homeless Clients per 10,000 Residents

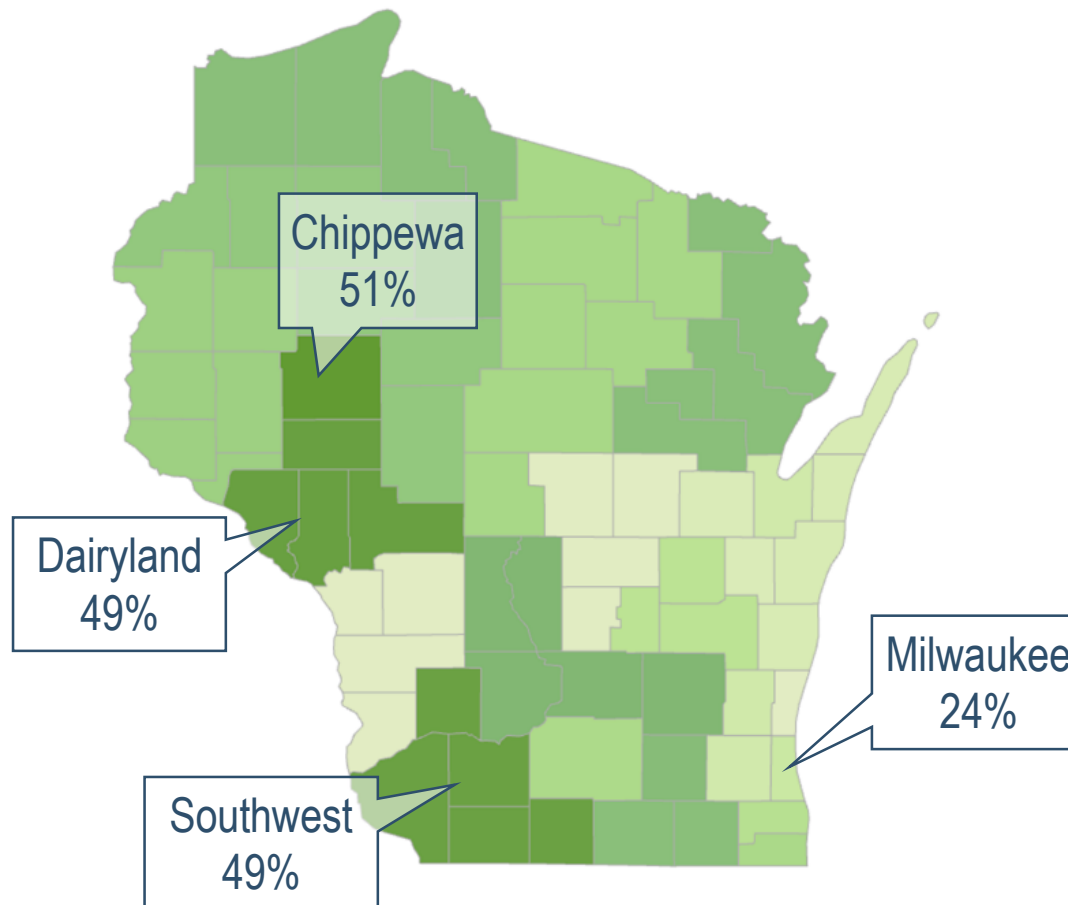

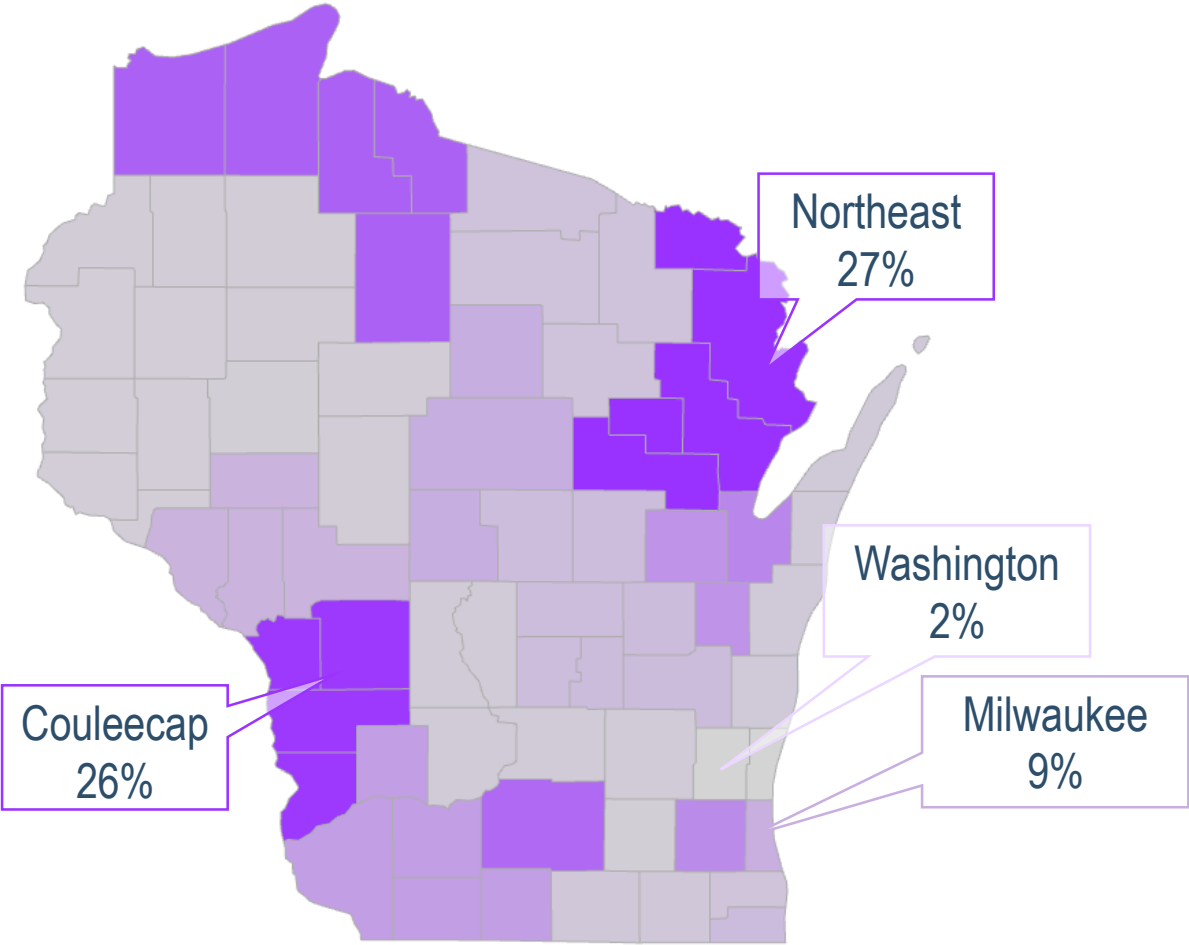

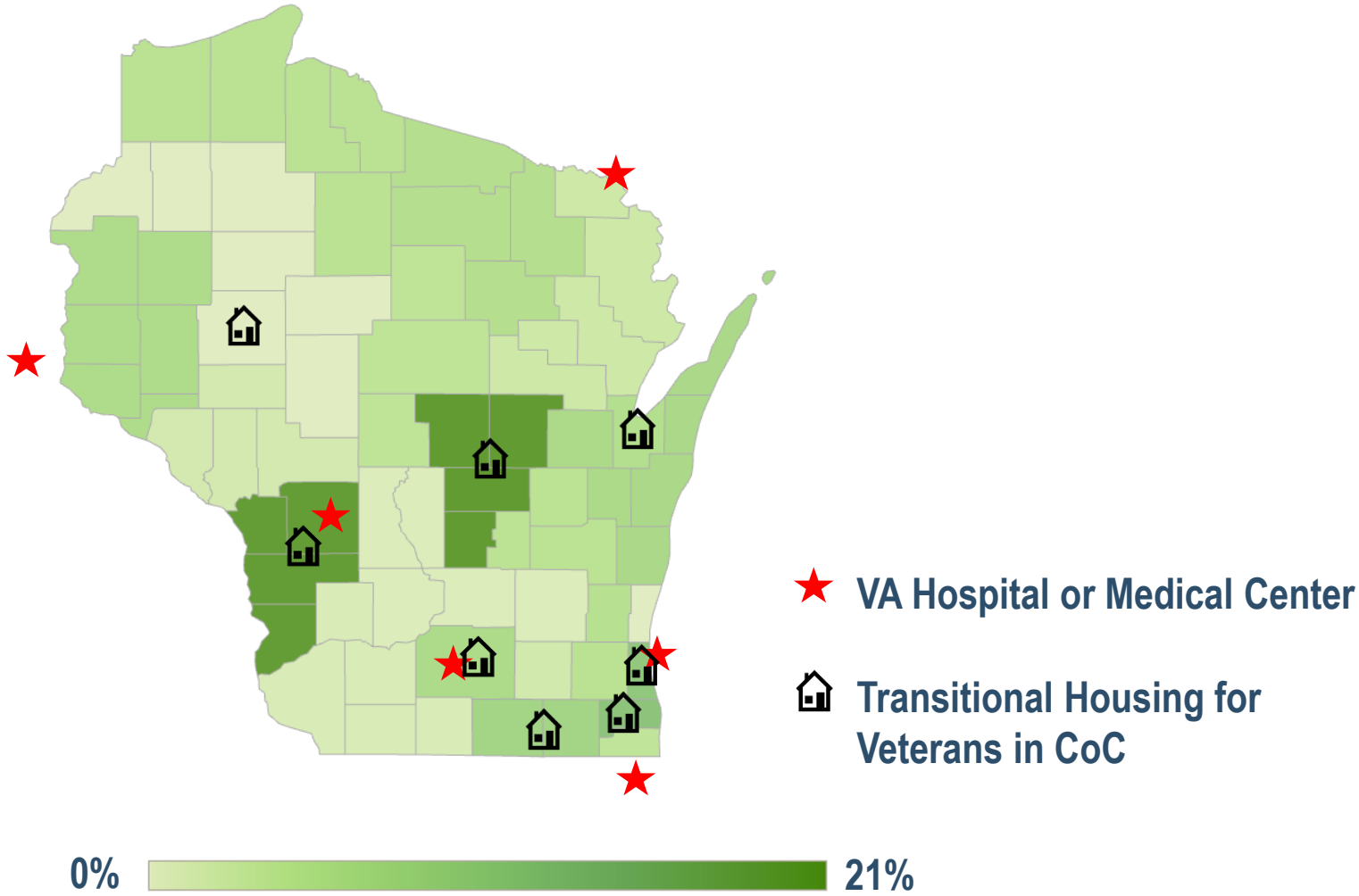
Homeless Children (Percent of Total Homeless)



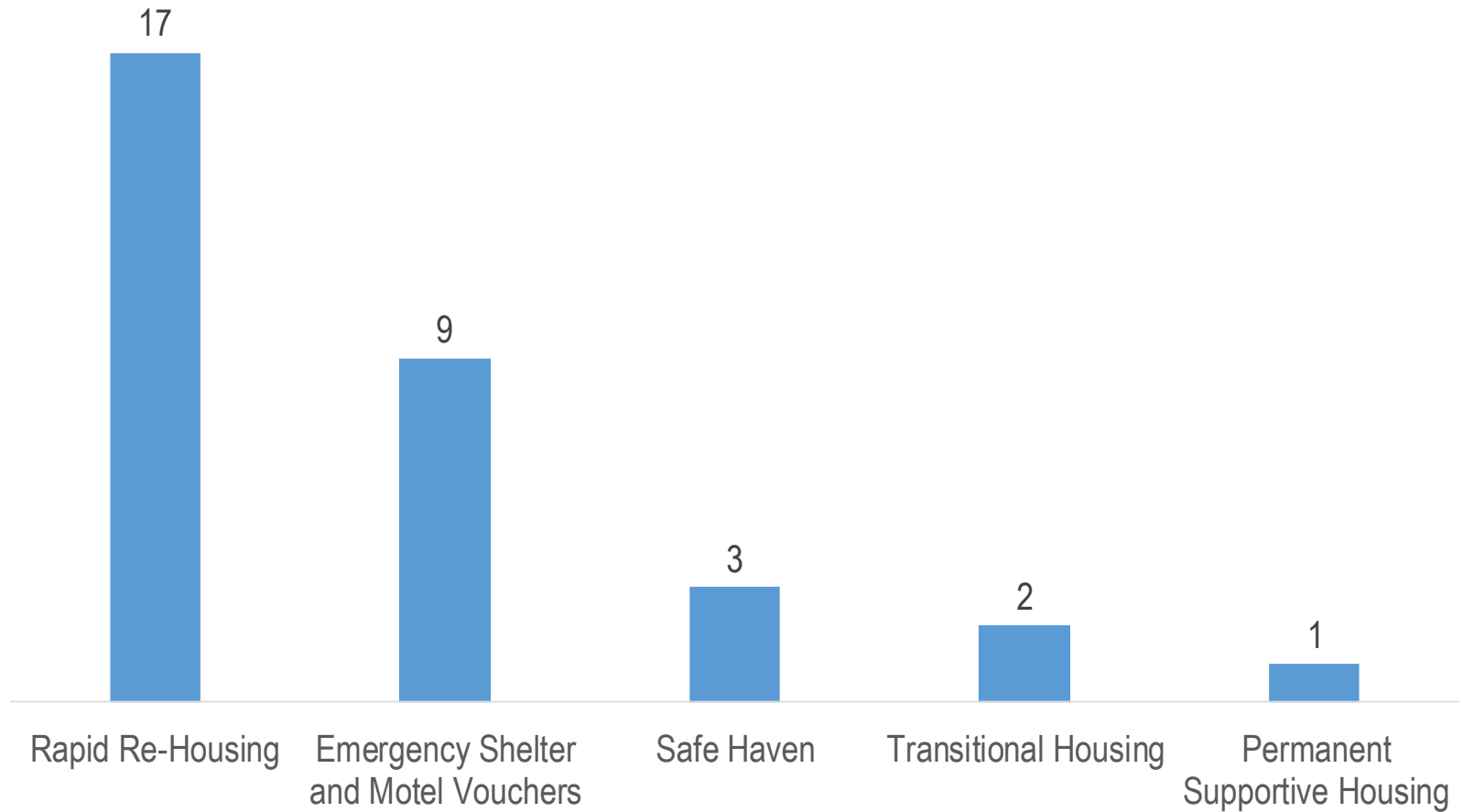

How Many Individuals Using Homeless Services are Veterans?

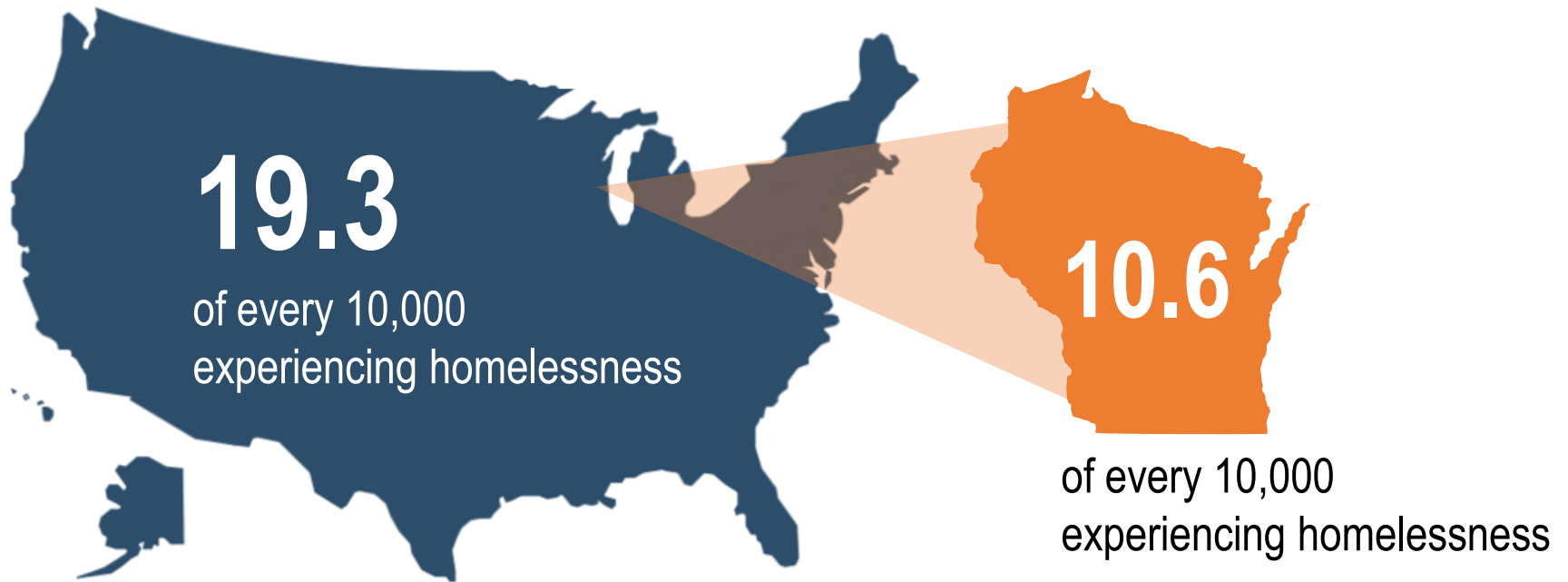


Clients Served per Bed
