



January 2014 Milwaukee Point in Time Count

The PIT was conducted on Wednesday January 29, 2014 from 7pm to 7am the following morning.

Agencies that assisted:

St. Ben's - Served as a Warming Room where individuals were able to stop in between the hours of 7pm-7am to fill out a survey and speak with volunteers.

Food and beverages were provided and individuals could stay as long as they wished. Some slept on the floor while others only came in to warm up.

Staff provided book bags filled with hygiene kits and snack bags to individuals who filled out a short survey. Also provided were sleeping bags and lots of conversation.

Desatar - Volunteered to be a warming site but had an unfortunate accident and their doors were closed. Their pipes had burst the morning of the count.

Tippecanoe - Also served as a Warming Room in a similar set-up as that of St. Ben's.

Hope House of Milwaukee - Served as the HUB station for dropping off donations, surveys and pick up spot for MPD ride-alongs.

Ride-alongs consisted of one police officer and two volunteers where they would locate common areas that homeless individuals frequent.

Milwaukee Police Department

Participated in ride-alongs between the hours of 9pm-3am; volunteers and police officers drove throughout the city of Milwaukee to locate possible areas frequented by homeless individuals.

Agencies that assisted con't:

West Allis Police Department - Participated in ride-alongs between the hours of 9pm-1am; volunteers and police officers drove throughout the city of West Allis to locate possible areas frequented by homeless individuals.

Wauwatosa Police Department - Participated in ride-alongs between the hours of 9pm-1am; volunteers and police officers drove throughout the city of Wauwatosa to locate possible areas frequented by homeless individuals.

Greenfield Police Department - Participated in ride-alongs between the hours of 9pm-1am; volunteers and police officers drove throughout the city of Greenfield to locate possible areas frequented by homeless individuals.

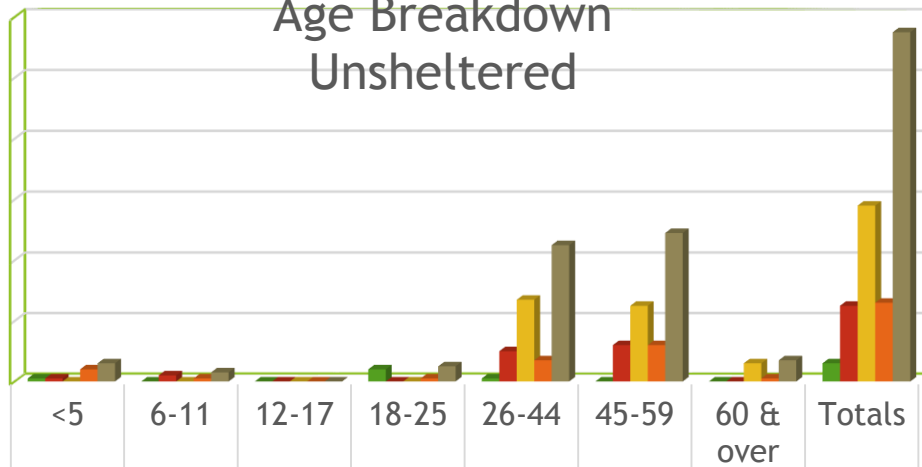
Pathfinders - Served as a drop-in location but also the first ever Youth Lock-In. Youth between the ages of 18-25 were able to stay at the drop -in location so that they may be counted for the PIT.

ServicePoint.

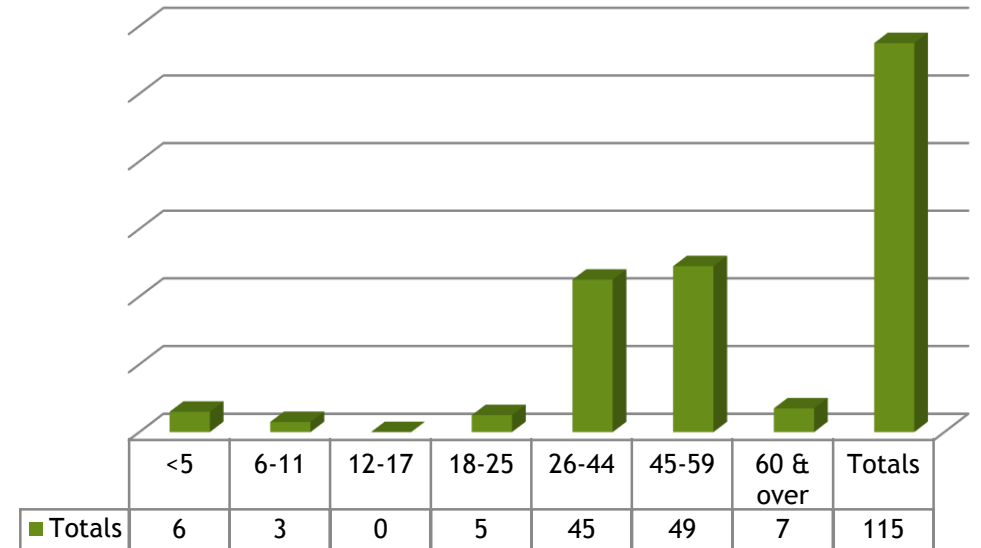

Reason for Homelessness - Unsheltered

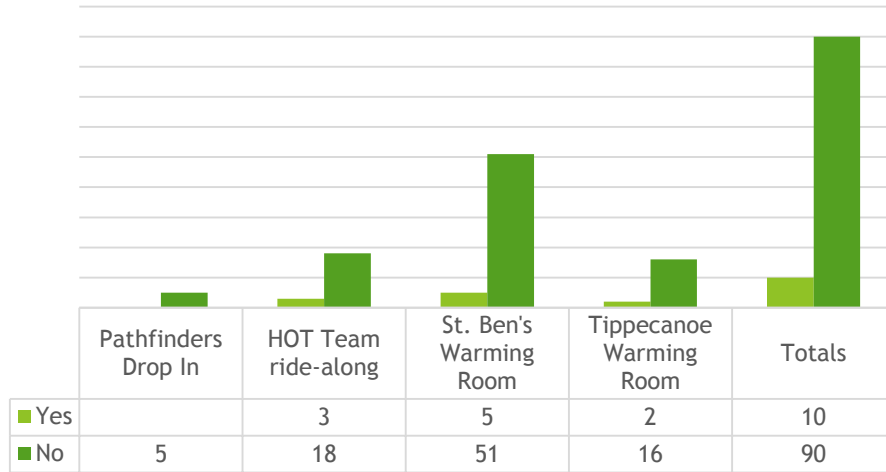

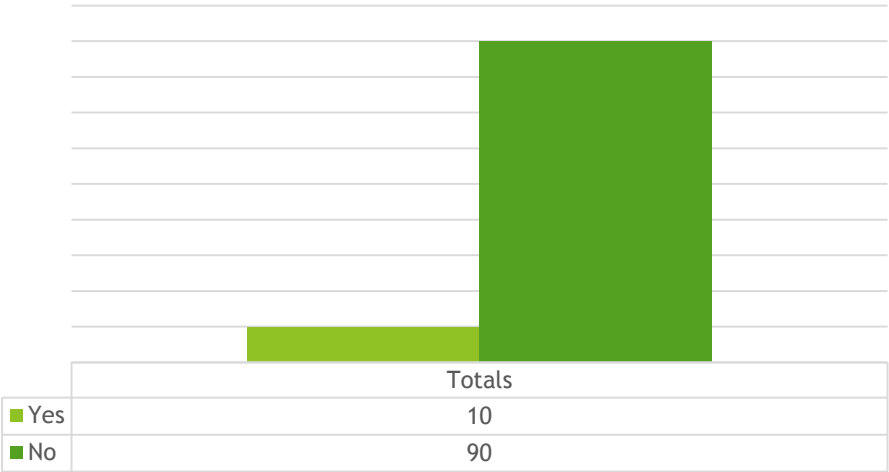
Sources of Income - Unsheltered



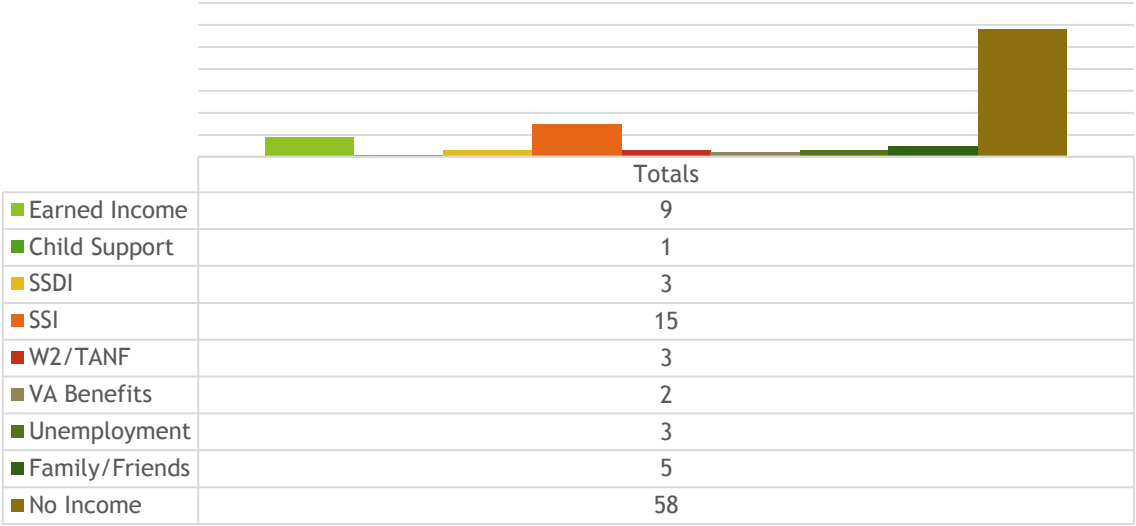

Sexual orientation - Unsheltered Voluntary Question



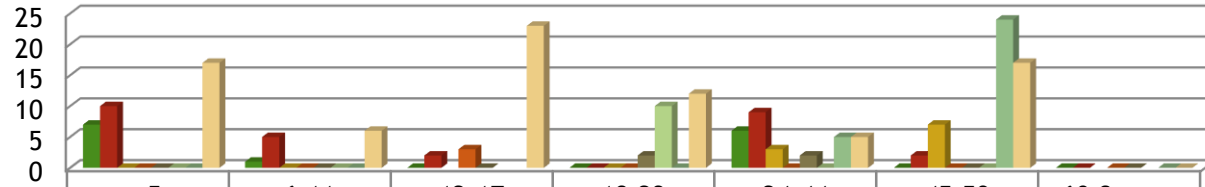

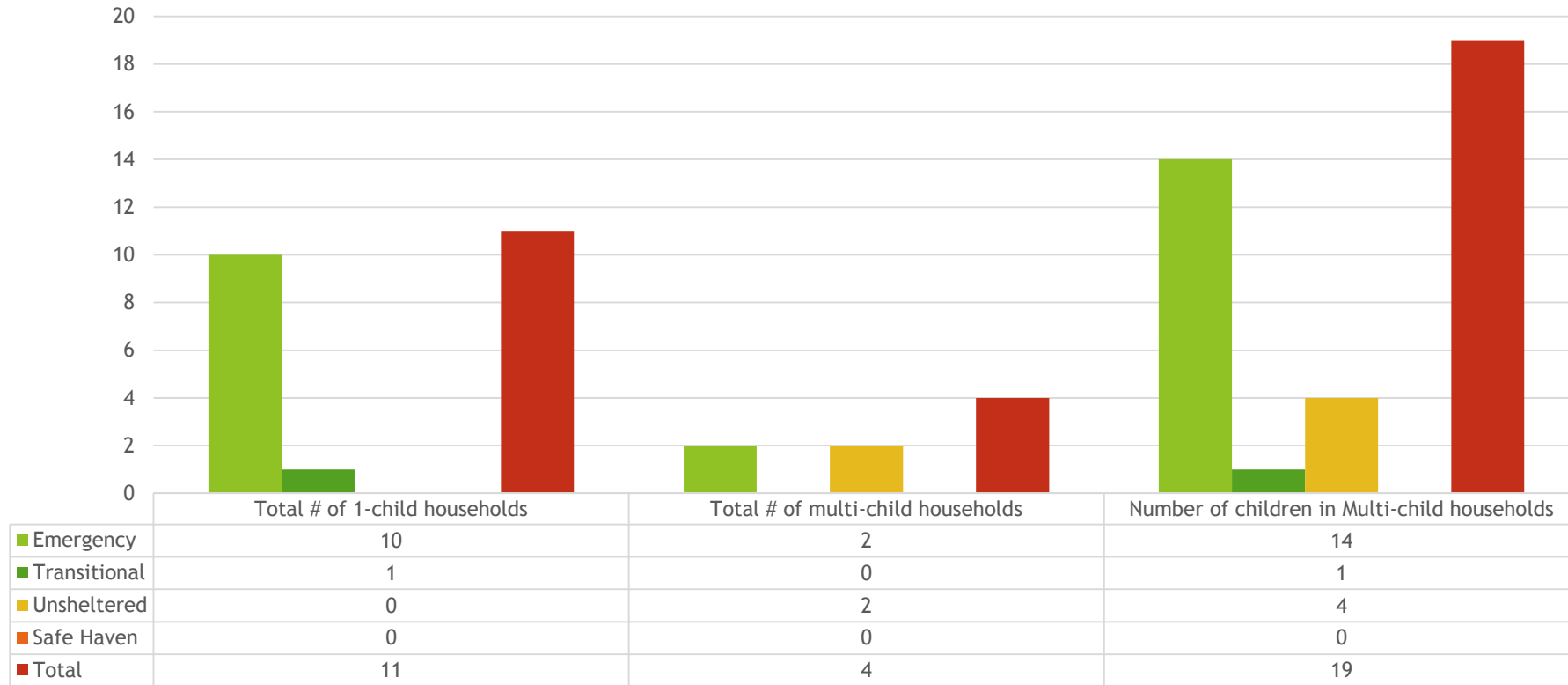

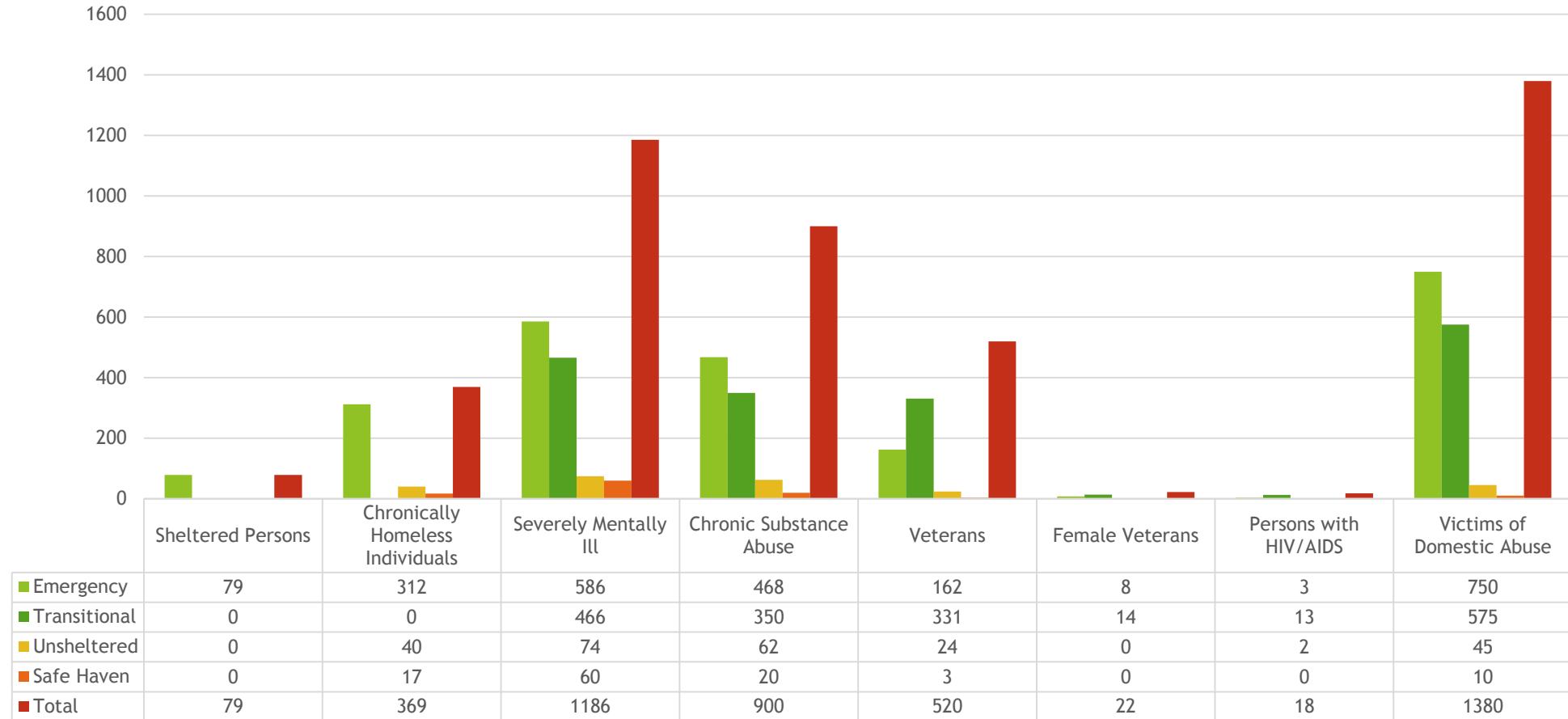
