

### Intake Data from Project Homeless Connect

A total of 260 guests were seen at the 2013 Project Homeless Connect event. A brief summary of the data is below:

#### ***Gender:***

By gender, 68% of those served were male (178) and 32% were female (82).

#### ***Race and Ethnicity:***

#### ***Veteran Status:***

Of the 260 guests served 12% (30) of those served indicated that they were veterans.

#### ***Domestic Violence:***

Of the 260 guests, 18% (46) of those served reported an experience in the past with domestic violence.

***Household Status:***

Guests were asked to self-identify their household type.

***Disability Information:***

The PHC intake form for 2013 asked “Do you have a disability of Long Duration” and allowed the guest to self-report this information. 128 guests (49%) responded Yes to this question.
