The City of Milwaukee is inviting citizen comments on the **Proposed Application and Project Listing Submissions for Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Competition.**

The Milwaukee Continuum of Care (Milwaukee CoC) is seeking to competitively apply for homeless assistance grant funds up to \$10,568,590 million from the Federal government as a result of the Continuum of Care Program interim rule. The proposed application details the Milwaukee CoC's use of the funds through the Continuum of Care Program.

The proposed application entails the funding amounts for existing renewal homeless projects already under a signed grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and new projects which meet eligibility standards. The proposed application is requested to reflect current homeless program activity and projected homeless demand.

The proposed application for the CoC NOFA will be available to the public beginning Friday, January 24, 2014 and can be picked up at the CDGA office located in Room 606, City Hall, 200 E. Wells Street. In addition, it can also be accessed at www.City.Milwaukee.gov/CommunityDevelopment310.htm.

The public viewing period is from Friday, January, 24, 2014 through Friday, January 31, 2014.
