Coordinated Entry: The current leadership group has met and will be establishing the Coordinated Entry Manual. This currently, the manual will be sent to the Providers to be reviewed and given the opportunity to respond with feedback. The position for the Coordinated Entry Coordinator position has been filled, congratulations to Emily Kenney! She will begin her position in the coming month.

CoC County-Wide Symposium: The CoC Symposium planning committee continues to meet! Potential venue is Miller Park. The Symposium is going to focus on targeted groups such as legislatures, community organizations, and community non-profits that work outside of the field of homelessness but are impacted by homelessness in some way, shape, or form. The committee is currently working to find a local keynote speaker; hoping to maybe bring a person of influence who has been formerly homeless.

Housing First Training: The City spoke with the HUD Technical Assistant consultants and the training will be a remote training as mentioned in meetings past. This is looking to be scheduled sometime in late July. The City,



HMIS lead agency, and the County recently had a phone conversation with the HUD TA. The TA will continue as normal, even during the NOFA.

July Point-In-Time: The Point in Time is coming up!! It will be held on July 27th at 7PM to the July 28th at 7AM. The Continuum's various Street Outreach groups will be working together with the Milwaukee Police Department to do the City of Milwaukee ride-alongs. There will be needed assistance with the suburban ride-alongs.

Project Homeless Connect: The CoC is also in the beginning stages of preparing for the Annual Project Homeless Connect! The date is set for October 20th, 2016 at Marquette University.
